

### **Survey Questions**


- 1. Overall, how would you rate Heart of Clojure? (range from excellent to poor)

- 4. What was your biggest takeaway from Heart of Clojure? (free text input)
- 5. What topics or features would you like to see at future Heart of Clojure conferences? *Could be topics or features you enjoyed in previous editions of Heart of Clojure.* (free text input)
- 6. How likely is it that you would recommend Heart of Clojure to a friend or colleague? (range from 10-1)

#### Data Analysis Methodology

Questions 1 & 6


Questions 2 - 5

For questions 1 and 6 where responses must be chosen on a scale, I counted the number of responses per rating. For the free text input responses for questions 2-5, I marked each response with a summary issue, i.e., "venues" or "speakers." If longer responses mentioned more than one issue, it was marked with multiple issues. I counted the total number of responses per issue. Overall, how would you rate Heart of Clojure? 56 responses






"The opening and closing keynotes where definitely food for thought. Chatting with fellow Clojurians told me how much we have in common even in our personal lives. It's unbelievable."

### What topics or features would you like to see at future Heart of Clojure conferences?




#### What topics or features would you like to see at future Heart of Clojure conferences?

#### Summary of Highlights and Lowlights

Attendees liked most the community, the vibe, and the speakers Attendees disliked the workshop space acoustics and aspects around food/lunch Takeaways centered on the people they met, being at a conference in general, & keynote message from Lu Wilson Attendees wish for more technical talks, architecture, Clojure at scale, workshops, & art/music live coding



#### Recommendations for the Future

01	Improve Attendee Experience	<ul> <li>Ask for feedback during conference to increase response rate</li> <li>Monitor feedback during conference to improve experience on the fly</li> </ul>
02	Food Labeling	• Ask caterers to provide a printout of the ingredients with their food
03	Workshop Sound Quality	<ul> <li>Use rooms with doors &amp; walls for workshops or</li> <li>Rent tour guides' equipment for workshop speakers</li> </ul>
04	Speaker Quality and Variety	• Send out call for proposals earlier and to a wider but also more targeted groups (ie, livecoding art & music makers, etc)

#### Summary of Big Picture

Overwhelmingly positive feedback

- 95% rate the conference excellent or very good

- 73% would definitely recommend HoC to friend / colleague
